## In Support of the Fiscal Pleasure Restoration Act of 2021: Squire Patton Boggs

Our own Mike Cullers was quoted in Law360 on Wednesday in an article about renewed hope for a full restoration of tax-exempt advance refundings of tax-advantaged bonds after their repeal by the TCJA.
