## **MUNICIPAL LIABILITY - MARYLAND**

### **Clark v. Prince George's County**

**Court of Special Appeals of Maryland - May 2, 2013 - A.3d - 2013 WL 1843380**

Furniture delivery person who had been shot and injured while making delivery inside county police officer's home, and relatives of second delivery person who had been shot and killed in same incident, brought action against county, alleging numerous tort claims and seeking damages for personal injuries and wrongful death.

The court of special appeals held that:

- County was entitled to governmental immunity from direct tort claims;
- Officer was not acting within scope of employment in shooting delivery persons; and
- Evidence officer's health history and prior violent acts was not admissible.
